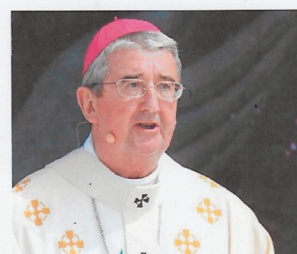

"The Church in Dublin: where will it be in ten years time?"

Archbishop Diarmuid Martin was ordained in May 1969. He later entered the service of the Holy See in the Pontifical Council for the Family. In 1998 he was appointed Titular Bishop of Glendalough and received the episcopal ordination at the hands of Pope John Paul II in St Peter's Basilica in 1999. He served as Secretary to the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace and later as Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the United Nations in Geneva. He was appointed Archbishop of Dublin in April 2004.
