

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

This Regulation came into effect on 25th May, across the EU. It strengthens the rights of individuals and gives you control over the personal data that is held by organisations. The Diocese has recently held briefings for parishes to assist them identify the personal data they hold (eg contact details, phone numbers, email addresses). Guidance will be provided by the Diocese as to the length of time that the Parish can hold your data in a secure manner.
