

SINGLE DAY TICKETS FOR THE FINAL MASS

Single Day Tickets for the Final Mass are free and will be available from this website on 25th June 2018.

At the moment the tickets for the Final Mass in the Phoenix Park <u>are not directly available</u> on general release until we have completed our consultations with the relevant statutory agencies on capacity, transport, security, safety and other issues. When these tickets become available they will be **free**. Tickets for this event will be released on **www.worldmeeting2018.ie** only on the **25th June 2018**.

- You will need a ticket for the event at Phoenix Park.
- From the 25th of June, book your ticket through an online form on www.worldmeeting2018.ie
 - Your ticket will be sent to you by email closer to the event.
- You must choose which event you would like to attend Phoenix Park or Knock. You will not be able to get tickets for both.

The Mass is a free event buy you will need a ticket to gain entry. Every adult and every child attending will need a ticket. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections. It is not possible to apply for tickets for both Phoenix Park and the Knock events, as these events are on the same day – you may only apply for one of these events. When registering for a ticket, you will be asked for the following information:

Information Why am I being asked for this? Name & postal address To identify you as the person applying for the ticket. Email address Your tickets will be sent by email Travel information You will be asked where you plan to travel from on the day and how you plan to travel. This information will inform your assigned route to follow for the event
