AN GARDA SÍOCHÁNA ARE PROMOTING A SUMMERTIME SAFETY CAMPAIGN.

Over €1.8 million worth of property was stolen from sheds/garages and gardens in summer burglaries in the last 12 months. Tools, gardening equipment and bicycles made up the majority of the value of property stolen.

As part of the Garda **'SUMMERTIME SAFETY'** campaign the public are encouraged to improve their home security.

LOCK UP

- 1 in 4 Burglars enter through open windows and doors.
- Store keys safely away from letter boxes and windows.
- Record details of valuables. Don't keep large amounts of cash at home.

VACANT HOUSES

- Make your home look occupied. Use light timer switches.
- Cancel deliveries. Have your post collected.
- Set your alarm.

TIDY GARDENS

- Cut grass before you go away on holiday.
- Prune trees and shrubs for clearer views.
- Securely store away bikes, tools and equipment.

PARK SMART SECURE YOUR VEHICLE

22% of all thefts from vehicles are at Residential Locations. 12am to 7am is when over half of these thefts occur.

33% of vehicles broken into are unlocked at the time. Driveways are the most common place for these thefts.

- JEWELLERY
- SUNGLASSES
- ELECTRONICS
- CASH
- SPORTS EQUIPMENT
- TOOLS

TIPS TO PREVENT THEFT

- Wherever you park your car or van, take your property with you.
- Ensure your vehicle is locked, alarmed and parked in a secure, well-lit location.
- Store your keys safely, away from windows and letterboxes.
