And through the One a new creation was made.

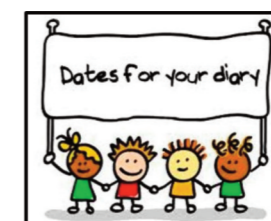
God the creator.
