PEOPLE OF HOPE - FAITH SHARING GROUP

The late Pope Benedict XVI said that Lent is like a retreat during which we turn back into ourselves and listen to the voice of God. And it is precisely with this intention in mind, that the Archdiocese of Dublin Office of Mission and Ministry is proposing a small faith sharing group resource entitled "People of Hope".

The resource uses the Scriptures from the Sundays in Lent as inspiration. Each of the six sessions (60 minutes) uses a different character from the Lenten Scriptures as a focus for reflection and sharing.

The "People of Hope" for the six sessions are JESUS; PETER, JAMES AND JOHN; SAMARITAN WOMAN; BLIND MAN; LAZARUS; and US. A local facilitator is available to lead the group. It is proposed that the group would meet once a week during Lent for the prayerful reading of God's Word.

The meetings will take place in the Meeting Room of the Parish Office from 10.30 - 11.30 on the following Wednesdays - Feb 22, March 1,8,15,22, 29.
